FIELD LIMIT: 48 (Amateur) and 24 (Mid-Amateur)

ENTRY FEE: \$200 | ENTRY DEADLINE: JUNE 15, 2020

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to female amateur golfers who: (1) meet the below age requirements, (2) have an up-to-date USGA Handicap Index issued by a WA Golf member club not exceeding 16.4 for Amateurs and 40.4 for Mid-Amateurs, and (3) are members in good standing of a WA Golf member club.

Age: No age requirements for Women's Amateur. Players in the Mid-Amateur must have reached their twenty-fifth birthday by June 30, 2020.

FIELD LIMIT

Field will be limited to the first 48 qualified Amateurs and the first 24 qualified Mid-Amateurs. Entries will be accepted according to the time of receipt of entry and entry fee in addition to exempt players.

This Championship runs concurrently with the Senior and Super Senior Women's Amateur, which has a field limit of 48. WA Golf reserves the right to modify either field limit to achieve a full field of 120 players.

ENTRIES: FORM, FEE, CLOSING DATE

All players, including those who are exempt, must have an entry application submitted either by: (1) at the WA Golf website (wagolf.org) with a credit card, or (2) by mail with a completed paper application form and check or credit card authorization form.

Entry fee of \$200 must be paid by every player. Payment will be processed at the time of entry. A full refund will be issued to players who are placed on a waiting list and do not make the starting field.

Entry applications, along with the appropriate fee, must be completed or received by WA Golf by 4:30 p.m. on Monday, June 15, 2020.

Late entry applications may be accepted and used to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the WA Golf staff establishes. Late entry applications will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact WA Golf in order to submit a late entry application. to achieve a full field of 120 players.

REFUND POLICY

WA Golf reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, on any matter, shall be final.

CONDITIONS

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DRESS CODE

Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing while on host club property. The WA Golf Dress Code Policy is available at the following link: wagolf.org/policies and will be provided to all players, along with any additional measures required by the host club, in the Player Memorandum.

CODE OF CONDUCT

WA Golf may reject an entry application, revoke an accepted application, expel from the Championship and/or suspend a player from future championships if the player engages in conduct detrimental to the integrity and image of the game of golf and/or public confidence in WA Golf. The WA Golf Code of Conduct Policy is available at the following link: wagolf.org/policies and will be provided to all players in the Player Memorandum.

CADDIES

A player may provide her own caddie. Host club caddies will not be available.

CARTS (Amateur)

The Local Rule prohibiting the use of motorized transportation as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.

As a general rule, players and their caddies must walk the course at WA Golf Championships. But consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), a disabled player or caddie may be permitted to use a golf cart as an accommodation to his or her disability. As required by the ADA, the PNGA will evaluate such requests on a case-by-case basis. The required form entitled Golf Cart Request Form (as well as additional important information for first time and subsequent requests for a cart) is available at the following link: wagolf.org/policies.

CARTS (Mid-Amateur)

Players and caddies may ride in a golf cart. Cart fees are \$17 per seat/day. Fees will be collected during registration.

PRACTICE ROUND

All players will be allowed one complimentary practice round prior to the Championship.

Consideration will be made for out-of-town players with regard to reserved starting times the day prior to the Championship. Contestants can reserve practice round times directly through the golf shop. All practice round times are at the discretion of the host club.

SCHEDULE

Championship - 48 Amateur and 24 Mid-Amateur players eligible. 54-hole stroke play. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole playoff.

UNOFFICIAL WITHDRAWAL

After the entry deadline and during play of the Championship, players must notify WA Golf and state her need to withdraw. Entrants who unofficially withdraw (by not notifying WA Golf or without having sufficient reason) will not be granted entry into any future WA Golf Championship for a minimum of two years.

ONSITE CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

Register in person at location and time listed in the Player Memorandum. Players must register prior to starting round one play.
