FIELD LIMIT: 120 | ENTRY FEE: \$225 | ENTRY DEADLINE: JUNE 14, 2021

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to male amateur golfers who: (1) have an up-to-date USGA Handicap Index issued by a WA Golf member club not exceeding 8.4, (2) are members in good standing of a WA Golf member club, and (3) meet one of the following requirements:

- On the Exempt Player List
- Qualify at one of the five qualifiers

Age: Player's date of birth is required on all entry forms. An application for a player who is a minor upon the date of submission, must be submitted by a parent/guardian, and list parent/guardian's name, phone number, and email address. The parent/guardian must agree to be bound by all terms and conditions on their behalf and on behalf of the minor player.

FIELD LIMIT

Field will be limited to 120 qualified entrants. At the close of entry, the field of 120 will be filled by exempt players and players who advance from the five qualifiers.

ENTRIES: FORM, FEE, CLOSING DATE

All players, including those who are exempt, must have an entry application submitted either by: (1) at the WA Golf website (wagolf.org) with a credit card, or (2) by mail with a completed paper application form and check or credit card authorization form.

Entry fee of \$225 must be paid by every player. Payment will be processed at the time of entry. Non-exempt players must pay the \$100 qualifying fee and will be charged the remaining \$125 upon qualifying.

Entry applications, along with the appropriate fee, must be completed or received by WA Golf by 4:30 p.m. on Monday, June 14, 2021.

Late entry applications may be accepted and used to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the WA Golf staff establishes. Late entry applications will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact the WA Golf in order to submit a late entry application.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds due to cancellation before the close of entry are subject to a \$10 service charge. After the close of entry and up until pairings are released, refunds for documented and approved medical reasons are subject to a \$25 service charge. No refund for any reason will be issued after pairings have been released.

CONDITIONS

WA Golf reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, on any matter, shall be final.

DRESS CODE

Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing while on host club property. The WA Golf Dress Code Policy is available at the following link: wagolf.org/policies and will be provided to all players, along with any additional measures required by the host club, in the Player Memorandum.

CODE OF CONDUCT

WA Golf may reject an entry application, revoke an accepted application, expel from the championship and/or suspend a player from future championships if the player engages in conduct detrimental to the integrity and image of the game of golf and/or public confidence in WA Golf. The WA Golf Code of Conduct Policy is available at the following link: wagolf.org/policies and will be provided to all players in the Player Memorandum.

CADDIES

A player may provide his own caddie. Host club caddies will not be available.

CARTS

The Local Rule prohibiting the use of motorized transportation as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect.

As a general rule, players and their caddies must walk the course at WA Golf Championships. But consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), a disabled player or caddie may be permitted to use a golf cart as an accommodation to his or her disability. As required by the ADA, WA Golf will evaluate such requests on a case-by-case basis. The required form entitled Golf Cart Request Form (as well as additional important information for first time and subsequent requests for a cart) is available at the following link: wagolf.org/policies.

PRACTICE ROUND

Practice rounds are not included in the entry for any of the qualifying sites.

The final field will receive one complimentary practice round prior to the

championship at Gold Mountain Golf Club.

SCHEDULE

Qualifying - 18-hole stroke play. Players may only attempt to qualify at one site. The exact number of qualifying spots available at each site will be determined after the close of entry. Any ties for the final qualifying places will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole playoff. Championship - 120 players eligible. 54-hole stroke play with a 36-hole cut to the low 60 players and ties. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole playoff.

STROKE LIMIT

Players must return a score within 15 strokes of the course rating during qualifying. Failure to do so will disqualify the player from entering a qualifier for a minimum of one year.

UNOFFICIAL WITHDRAWAL

After the entry deadline and during play of the championship, players must notify WA Golf and state his need to withdraw. Entrants who unofficially withdraw (by not notifying WA Golf or without having sufficient reason) will not be granted entry into any future WA Golf Championship for a minimum of two years.

ONSITE CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

Register in person at location and time listed in the Player Memorandum. Players must register prior to starting qualifying or round one championship play.
