FIELD LIMIT: 36 Sides (Men) | 24 Sides (Senior) | 12 Sides (Super Senior) ENTRY FEE: \$430 | ENTRY DEADLINE: May 9, 2024

ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to sides of male amateur golfers who: (1) have an up-to-date USGA Handicap Index issued by a WA Golf member club not exceeding 36.4, and (2) are members in good standing of a WA Golf member club.

AGE:

Player's date of birth is required on all entry forms. No age requirements for players in the Men's Championship. Players in the Senior Championship must have reached their fifty-fifth birthday by May 23, 2024. Players in the Super Senior Flight must have reached their sixty-fifth birthday by May 23, 2024.

FIELD LIMIT

Field will be limited to 36 qualified Men's sides, 24 qualified Senior sides, and 12 qualified Super Senior sides. At the close of entry, the Men's Championship, Senior Men's Championship and Super Senior Flight will each be filled by the teams with the lowest combined handicap indexes in addition to exempt teams. A list of registered teams with handicap index is available on online at wagolf.org.

WA Golf reserves the right to modify either field limit after the entry deadline to achieve a full field of 72 sides.

ENTRIES: FORM, FEE, CLOSING DATE

All sides, including those who are exempt, must have an entry application submitted either by: (1) at the WA Golf website (wagolf.org) with a credit card, or (2) by mail with a completed paper application form and check or credit card authorization form.

Entry fee of \$430 must be paid by every side. Payment will be processed at the time of entry.

Entry applications, along with the appropriate fee, must be completed or received by WA Golf by 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 9, 2024.

Late entry applications may be accepted and used to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the WA Golf staff establishes. Late entry applications will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact WA Golf in order to submit a late entry application.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds due to cancellation before the close of entry are subject to a \$10 service charge. After the close of entry and up until round one pairings are released, teams that withdraw for any reason will be refunded 50% of the entry fee. No refund for any reason will be issued after round one pairings have been released.

CONDITIONS

WA Golf reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, on any matter, shall be final.

DRESS CODE

Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing while on host club property. The WA Golf Dress Code Policy is available at the following link: wagolf.org/ policies and will be provided to all players, along with any additional measures required by the host club, in the Player Memorandum.

CODE OF CONDUCT

WA Golf may reject an entry application, revoke an accepted application, expel from the championship and/or suspend a player from future championships if the player engages in conduct detrimental to the integrity and image of the game of golf and/or public confidence in WA Golf. The WA Golf Code of Conduct Policy is available at the following link: wagolf.org/policies and will be provided to all players in the Player Memorandum.

CADDIES

A player may provide his own caddie. Host club caddies will not be available.

CARTS

Players and caddies may ride in a golf cart. Cart fees are \$40 per team, per day. Fees will be collected during registration.

PRACTICE ROUND

All players will be allowed one complimentary practice round prior to the championship. Information regarding the scheduling of practice rounds will be distributed to players after the entry deadline. Players may not schedule a complimentary practice round until entries have closed and the field is set.

SCHEDULE

Championship - 36-hole four-ball stroke play (gross only). In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole playoff.

UNOFFICIAL WITHDRAWAL

During play of the championship, players must notify WA Golf of their need to withdraw and fill out a withdraw form. Entrants who unofficially withdraw (by not notifying WA Golf or without having sufficient reason) will not be granted entry into any future WA Golf Championship for a minimum of two years.

ONSITE CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

Register in person at location and time listed in the Player Memorandum. Players must register prior to starting round one play.
