ENTRY FEE: \$200 | ENTRY DEADLINE: AUGUST 6, 2024



ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to female amateur golfers who: (1) meet the below age requirements, (2) have an up-to-date USGA Handicap Index issued by a WA Golf member club not exceeding 40.4, and (3) are members in good standing of a WA Golf member club.

Age: Player's date of birth is required on all entry forms. Senior players must have reached their fiftieth birthday by August 20, 2024. Super Senior players must have reached their sixty-fifth birthday by August 20, 2024.

FIELD LIMIT

Field will be limited to the first 48 qualified Seniors and the first 24 qualified Super Seniors. Entries will be accepted according to the time of receipt of entry and entry fee in addition to exempt players. WA Golf reserves the right to modify either field limit to achieve a full field of 72 players.

ENTRIES: FORM, FEE, CLOSING DATE

All players, including those who are exempt, must have an entry application submitted either by: (1) at the WA Golf website (wagolf.org) with a credit card, or (2) by mail with a completed paper application form and check or credit card authorization form.

Entry fee of \$200 must be paid by every player. Payment will be processed at the time of entry. A full refund will be issued to players who are placed on a waiting list and do not make the starting field.

Entry applications, along with the appropriate fee, must be completed or received by WA Golf by 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 6, 2024.

Late entry applications may be accepted and used to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the WA Golf staff establishes. Late entry applications will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact WA Golf in order to submit a late entry application.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds due to cancellation before the close of entry are subject to a \$10 service charge. After the close of entry and up until pairings are released, players who withdraw for any reason will be refunded 50% of the entry fee. No refund for any reason will be issued after pairings have been released.

CONDITIONS

WA Golf reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, on any matter, shall be final.

DRESS CODE

Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing while on host club property. The WA Golf Dress Code Policy is available at the following link: wagolf.org/policies and will be provided to all players, along with any additional measures required by the host club, in the Player Memorandum.

CODE OF CONDUCT

WA Golf may reject an entry application, revoke an accepted application, expel from the championship and/or suspend a player from future championships if the player engages in conduct detrimental to the integrity and image of the game of golf and/or public confidence in WA Golf. The WA Golf Code of Conduct Policy is available at the following link: wagolf.org/policies and will be provided to all players in the Player Memorandum.

CADDIES

A player may provide her own caddie. Host club caddies will not be available.

CARTS

Players may ride in a golf cart. Cart fees are \$20 per player, per day. Fees will be collected during registration.

PRACTICE ROUND

All players will be allowed one complimentary practice round prior to the championship. Players may not schedule their complimentary practice round until after entries have closed and the field is set.

SCHEDULE

Championship - 48 Senior and 24 Super Senior players eligible. 36-hole stroke play (gross and net). In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole playoff.

UNOFFICIAL WITHDRAWAL

During play of the championship, a competitor who withdraws must notify WA Golf staff and fill out a withdraw form. Entrants who unofficially withdraw (by not notifying WA Golf or without having sufficient reason) will not be granted entry into any future WA Golf Championship for a minimum of two years.

ONSITE CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

Register in person at location and time listed in the Player Memorandum. Players must register prior to starting round one play.
