### **ELIGIBILITY**

Entries are open to female amateur golfers who: (1) have an up-to-date USGA Handicap Index issued by a WA Golf member club, (2) are members in good standing of a WA Golf member club, and (3) meet at least one of the following requirements.

- Club Champion of a WA Golf Member Club (2023 or 2024)
- Past Champion of the Women's Champion of Champions (2020-2024)
- Past Champion of Senior Women's Champion of Champions (2020-2024)
- Champion of a WA Golf Championship; excluding Parent-Child and Mixed Chapman Championships (2024)
- Champion of any event on the WA Golf Women's Performance Points List (2024)
- Champion of any event on the WA Golf Senior Women's Performance Points List (2024)
- Top-5 on the WA Golf Women's Performance Points List (2024)
- Top-5 on the WA Golf Women's Mid-Amateur Performance Points List (2024)
- Top-5 on the WA Golf Senior Women's Performance Points List (2024)
- Top-5 on the WJGA Girls' Performance Points List (2024)
- WJGA State Junior Girls Champion (2024)
   Age: Player's date of birth is required
   on all entry forms. No age requirements for
   Women's Championship. Players in the Senior
   Women's Championship must have reached
   their fiftieth birthday by April 24, 2025.

### FIELD LIMIT

Field will be limited to the first 18 qualified Women and the first 30 qualified Senior Women. Entries will be accepted according to the time of receipt of entry and entry fee in addition to exempt players.

This championship runs concurrently with the Men's and Senior Men's Champion of Champions, which has a field limit of 108. WA Golf reserves the right to modify either field limit to achieve a full field of 156 players.

### **ENTRIES: FORM, FEE, CLOSING DATE**

All players, including those who are exempt, must have an entry application submitted either by: (1) on the WA Golf website (wagolf.org) with a credit card, or (2) by mail with a completed paper application form and check or credit card authorization form.

Entry fee of \$200 must be paid by every player. Payment will be processed at the time of entry. A full refund will be issued to players who are placed on a waiting list and do not make the starting field.

Entry applications, along with the appropriate fee, must be completed or received by WA Golf by 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 10, 2025.

Late entry applications may be accepted and used to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the WA Golf staff establishes. Late entry applications will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact WA Golf in order to submit a late entry application.

### **REFUND POLICY**

Refunds due to cancellation before the close of entry are subject to a \$10 service charge. After the close of entry and up until round one pairings are released, players who withdraw for any reason will be refunded 50% of the entry fee. No refund for any reason will be issued after round one pairings have been released

### **CONDITIONS**

WA Golf reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, on any matter, shall be final.

### **DRESS CODE**

Players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing while on host club property. The WA Golf Dress Code Policy is available at the following link: wagolf.org/policies and will be provided to all players, along with any additional measures required by the host club, in the Player Memorandum.

### **CODE OF CONDUCT**

WA Golf may reject an entry application, revoke an accepted application, expel from the championship and/or suspend a player from future championships if the player engages in conduct detrimental to the integrity and image of the game of golf and/or public confidence in WA Golf. The WA Golf Code of Conduct Policy is available at the following link: wagolf.org/policies and will be provided to all players in the Player Memorandum.

### **CADDIES**

A player may provide her own caddie. Host club caddies will not be available.

### CARTS

Players or caddies may ride in a golf cart. Cart fees are \$20 per seat/day. Fees will be collected during registration. (NOTE: The WA Golf "One Seat" Cart Policy is in effect at all WA Golf Championships. The full policy is available online at wagolf.org/policies)

### PRACTICE ROUND

All players will be allowed one complimentary practice round prior to the championship. Information regarding the scheduling of practice rounds will be distributed to players after the entry deadline. Players may not schedule a complimentary practice round until entries have closed and the field is set.

### **SCHEDULE**

Championship - 18 Women and 30 Senior Women players eligible. 36-hole stroke play (gross only). In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole playoff.

### **UNOFFICIAL WITHDRAWAL**

During play of the championship, players must notify WA Golf of their need to withdraw and fill out a withdraw form. Entrants who unofficially withdraw (by not notifying WA Golf or without having sufficient reason) will not be granted entry into any future WA Golf Championship for a minimum of two years.

# ONSITE CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION

Players must register in person at the location and time listed in the Player Memorandum. Players must register prior to starting round one play.
